

School fees 2011

Board set fees and levies for the next year in term 3.

One invoice is sent after the commencement of the school year, followed by monthly statements showing payments made thus far. This allows families to know exactly what is remaining to be paid by the end of the school year.

Capital Levy Fund

The capital levy for 2011 will be \$165 per family. This will be added to your invoice in February.

Discounts apply for two or more children attending SHCS, 3 or more children in Catholic schools and early payment discount for full payment of fees prior to 31st March.

Fees may be paid weekly, fortnightly, monthly or annually. Cash, cheque, EFTPOS, direct debit, centrepay and scheduled or manual credit card facilities are available.

Parental Participation

Parental involvement is encouraged at Sacred Heart School with options for parents to participate in class based activities, day trips or longer camping trips.

On a yearly basis the teachers plan for specific activities, which involve children, parents and the wider local community. All volunteers in Catholic Schools are required to have a police check completed before participating in these activities. Forms are available at the school office.
